STRONG FOUNDATION FOR CONTINUAL GROWTH

We are committed to lasting spiritual formation practices, established on a biblical worldview. As our student body increases, we will meet the growth by intentionally developing our staff. Led by our Talent Stewardship team, Impact 360 Institute invests in our staff professionally and spiritually, specifically through the following:

Equipping Young Professionals

Impact 360 Masters continues to grow. Three students graduated and 16 students continue to pursue a Masters of Arts in Leadership through our partnership with North Greenville University. This residential degree program offers two concentrations: Servant Leadership and Spiritual Formation. We are expanding and looking forward to 20 students in the fall of 2022 and up to 25 in 2023.

HANDS-ON EXPERIENCES FOR LIFE

Impact 360 Fellows are equipped to navigate secular, cultural forces while being grounded in historical Christianity. Fellows focus on who they are becoming in Christ and envision what kind of Kingdom influence God is preparing them to have. This training includes off-campus experiences where they take what they're learning in the classroom put it into practice.

We continue to equip high school students through our summer experiences, **Impact 360 Propel** and **Impact 360 Immersion**. Despite the disappointment of prayerfully deciding to close programing in 2020, registration for summer 2021 was in high demand. This summer, we reached capacity with a total of 140 students attending Immersion and Propel. Impact 360 Institute's summer programs continue to empower high school students to own their faith; many of them even decide to continue their discipleship journey with us by applying to the Fellows experience.

A MULTIPLYING DISCIPLESHIP MOVEMENT

We launched a new student program in May 2020 called The 3 Initiative, a missional discipleship community for recently commissioned Impact 360 Fellows.
